

Leaving the Airport



The connection between Václav Havel Airport and Prague city centre is provided by public transport bus lines operating at regular few-minute intervals. Bus stops are located directly in front of terminals.


59 Bus Line

Direction: Veleslavín train station

Change to Metro Line A (Nádraží Veleslavín) 

100 Bus Line

Direction: Zličín

Change to Metro Line B (Zličín) 




The direct connection between Václav Havel Airport and Prague Main Railway Station is provided by Airport Express buses which stop directly outside the main railway station building.

AE Bus

Direction: Prague Main Railway Station

Change to Metro Line C (Hlavní Nádraží)
