
Tickets & Travel Passes



If you travel around Prague by public transport, you should purchase a single-use ticket or a long-term travel pass. The travel pass can be purchased at a discounted price with your ISIC student card.

Airport Express Bus Tickets

If you take the AE Bus from or to Václav Havel Airport, you are required to purchase a ticket specifically for the AE line. Regular public transport tickets will not be accepted.

Price: 100 CZK

Where to purchase: At the České Dráhy cashier counter, from the AE driver

Payment method: Cash or card

Luggage: Free of charge, designated luggage storage space in the bus

Tickets & Travel Passes

PID Lítačka Card

To purchase a long-term travel pass and use Prague's public transport without limitations you need to get the Lítačka card. The easiest way to order the card is by filling in an online application on the PID Lítačka website.

Price: 50 CZK How to purchase: by registering here Processing time: 30 days Pick up: Via post, or at one of the contact points

Important!

You should always carry your Lítačka card with you in case of an inspection. Otherwise, you will be fined up to **1,500 CZK**.

Types of long-term travel passes

You need to select between two Lítačka travel pass tariffs depending on your age. If you are under 26, the student tariff is available for you. If you are over 26, you are required to purchase the pass at full price.

PID Litačka app. This is the most convenient way to purchase not only long-term passes but also single-use tickets. On top of that, the mobile app allows you to register your phone as a travel pass in case you do not wish to order a plastic Lítačka card. You can download the app here.

Important!

Once you purchase an electronic ticket or a long-term pass, there is a **2-minute activation** window during which your ticket is not valid. If a transport inspector checks you at this time. you will be fined. Please keep this in mind when using public transport in Prague.
